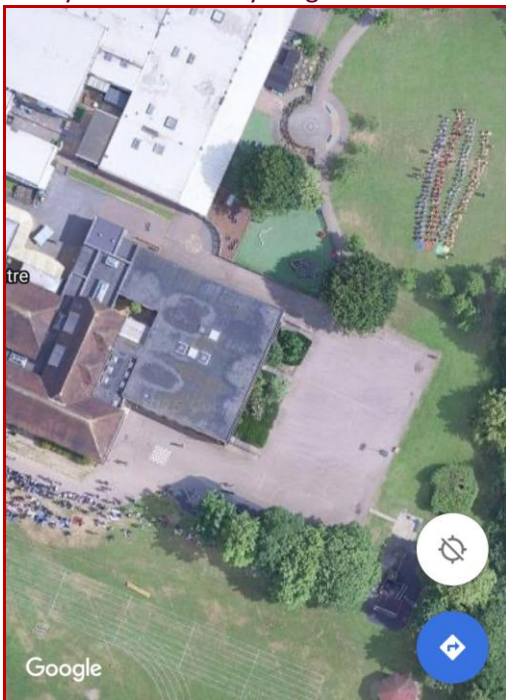

We frequently receive telephone calls and emails about inconsiderate parking and upsetting dialogue between our neighbours and parents. Our neighbours beg us to do something about this. We have fielded several complaints this week alone.

One of our neighbours is particularly upset due to her personal circumstances, which we can share as an example. This particular resident has an elderly father who is terminally ill. He has a Macmillan nurse visiting him every morning. This week the nurse has not been able to park on their drive at all, as access has been blocked. She has had to park near Tesco's and walk up to the house. This inevitably means her time is shortened with this family as she has another to move on to.

We need your help! Please respect our neighbours and allow them full access to their drives and homes. You might be in a rush, but you do not know what their challenges might be.
